

WPAZ MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

WPAZ membership comes in two types, which are full membership and associate membership.

Full membership shall be open to persons or corporate bodies directly engaged in the business of Wildlife production, translocation, and management for which they shall pay an annual subscription fee.

Associate membership shall be open to persons, associations or corporate bodies indirectly engaged or interested in the business of Wildlife production and management for which they shall pay an annual subscription fee.

Below are the membership requirements:

No	Item	Description
1.0	Full membership: Private Wildlife Estate - PWE)	Applicants are required to submit the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Copies of the current Permit to Keep Animals in Captivity ii. Certificate of Ownership iii. Completed WPAZ Membership Application Form and pay a US\$200 membership fee.
1.1	Full membership: Open Game Ranches (OGR)	Applicants are required to fill out the WPAZ application form and pay a US\$200 membership fee.
1.2	Full membership: Community Game Ranches	Applicants are required to fill out the WPAZ application form and pay a US\$50 membership fee.
1.3	Full membership renewals – Private Wildlife Estate (Game Ranch)	Members renewing their membership require: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Copies of the current Permit to Keep Animals in Captivity ii. Certificate of Ownership iii. DNPW Annual Return Form iv. The yellow copies from the previous years' GTP book.
1.4	Full membership renewal: Open Game Ranch	Members renewing their membership require payment of a fee of US\$200.
1.5	Full membership renewal: Community Game Ranch	Members renewing their membership require: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Payment of fee US\$50 ii. Submit DNPW Annual Return Form
2.0	Associate membership – Individual interested in wildlife conservation	Members renewing their membership require payment of a fee of US\$50.

2.1	Associate membership – Game meat sales	Applicants are required to submit the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Completed WPAZ application form. ii. Authority to sell game meat or a permit to sell game meat from DNPW. iii. The yellow copies from the previous years’ Game Trading Book as an annual return.
2.2	Associate membership- Capture companies	Applicants are required to submit the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Completed WPAZ application form. ii. Recognition letter as a registered capture company from DNPW iii. The yellow copies from the previous years’ Game Trading Book as an annual return.
	Associate membership- Auxiliary services	Applicants are required to submit the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Completed WPAZ application form.
2.3	Associate membership – Government or regulatory body.	<p>“persons” currently employed by regulatory bodies such as DNPW, Vet Department where the possibility of a conflict of interest may occur. Such persons would be obliged to provide a letter of “NO Objection” from their Head of Department</p> <p>Applicants are required to submit the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Completed WPAZ application form ii. A letter of recommendation from their Director stating that there is no conflict of interest between their full-time occupation and their interest in WPAZ. iii. Authority to sell game meat or a permit to sell game meat from DNPW (only applies to game meat dealers) iv. List of legal game meat suppliers (only applies to game meat dealers).
2.4	Associate Membership- NGOs and Associations	Applicants are required to submit the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Completed WPAZ application form
2.5	Honorary members	Members that have provided services to WPAZ for example Department of National Parks and Wildlife and Department of Veterinary Services.

3.0	Review of Applications by Executive Committee	The time taken for Executive Committee to review and approve an application is 5 working days.

NB: Both Full and Associate members must be in compliance with all applicable laws of Zambia. The Association has the right and reject an application if the applicant does not meet the requirements.
